

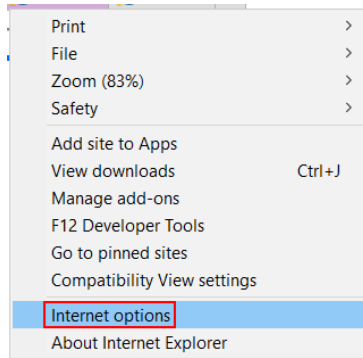
How to Enable Pop-Ups in your Web Browser

Internet Explorer 11

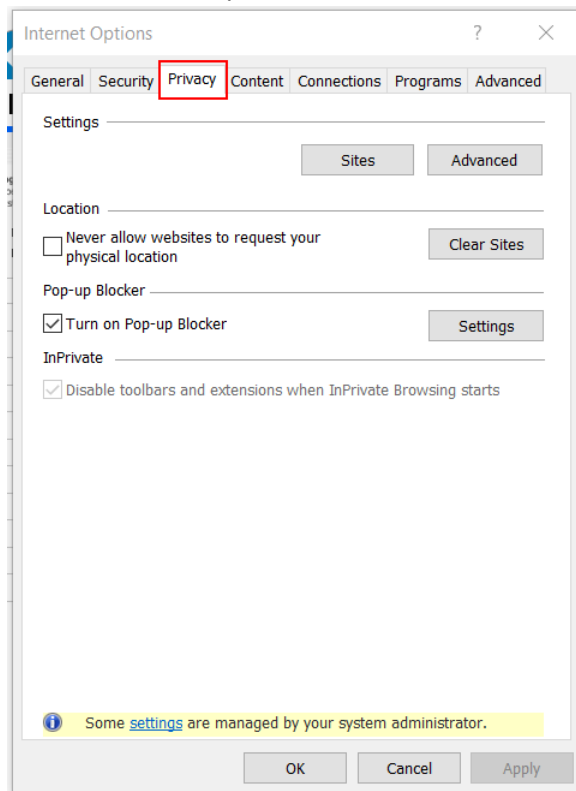
1. Click on the cog in the top right-hand corner



2. Click on Internet Options

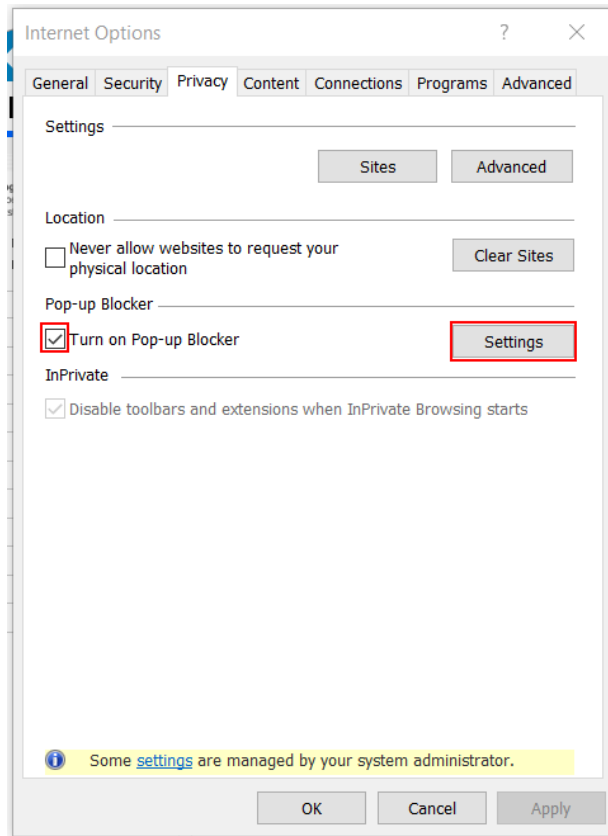


3. Click on the Privacy Tab



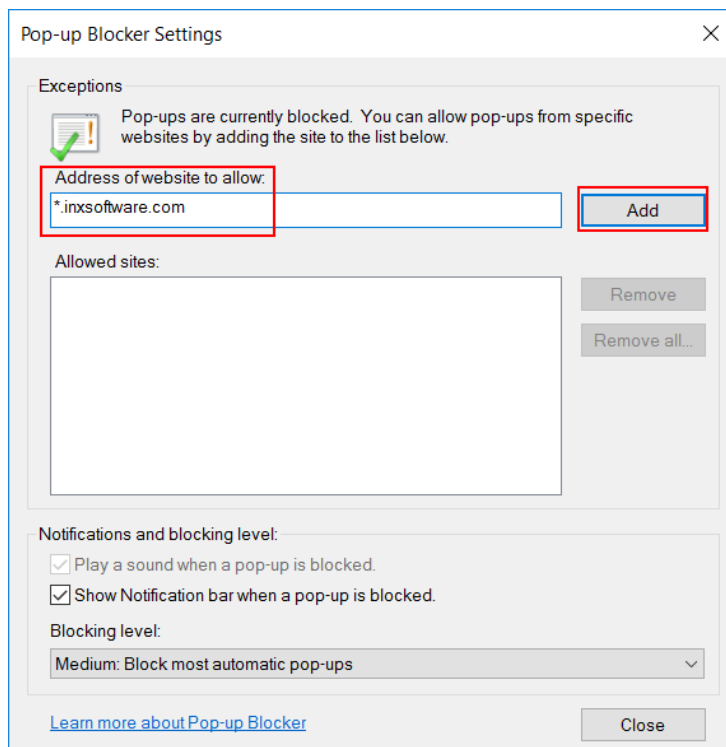
4. If the Pop-Up Blocker is turned on, there will be a tick in the checkbox alongside the text "Turn on Pop-up Blocker".

Click on Settings



Note: If there is not a tick in the checkbox then pop-ups are not blocked.

5. Type in *.inxsoftware.com into the "Address of website to allow:" textbox and then click the Add button



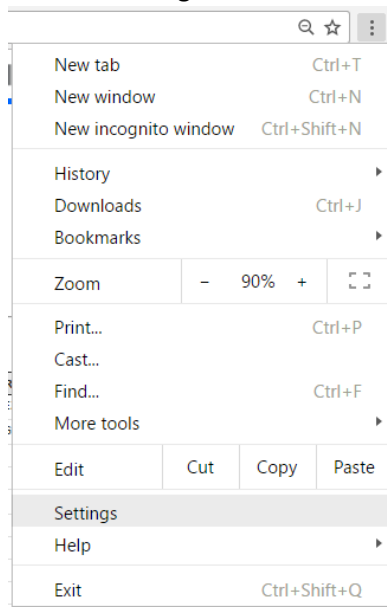
6. Click on Close and then OK

Google Chrome

1. Click on the 3 dots in the top right hand corner



2. Click on Settings



3. At the bottom of the page, click on [Show advanced settings...](#)

4. Click on [Content settings...](#) in the Privacy section

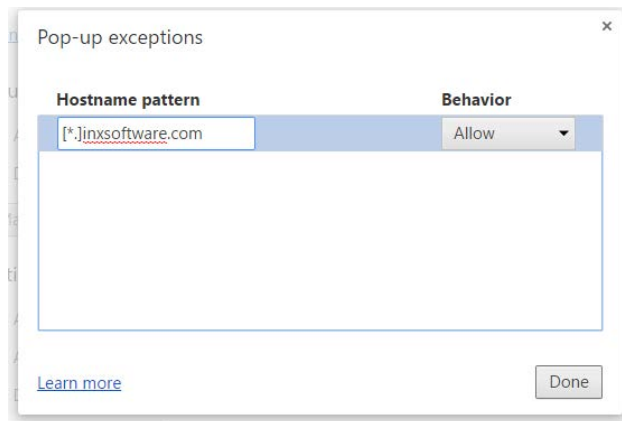
5. Scroll down to the Pop-ups section and click on [Manage exceptions...](#)

Pop-ups

- Allow all sites to show pop-ups
- Do not allow any site to show pop-ups (recommended)

6. Type `[*.]inxsoftware.com` into the Hostname pattern textbox and change the Behaviour to Allow. Click on Done.




7. Click on Done and then close the Settings tab

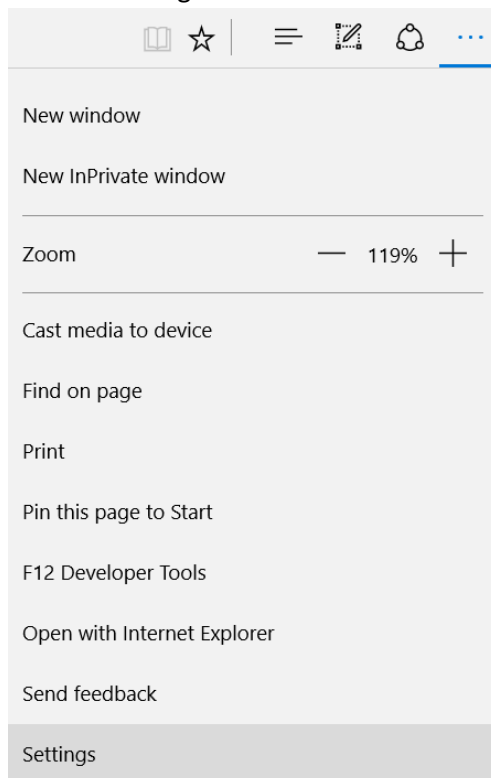


Microsoft Edge

Currently there is no way to enable pop-ups for individual sites as of version 25.10586.0.0. It is expected that this will be released in a future version.

However, you can turn on or off all pop-ups in Microsoft Edge. It may be useful for you to temporarily turn off the blocker whilst doing your on-line training and then turning it back on.

1. Click on the  in the top right hand corner
2. Click on Settings



3. Scroll down and click on [View advanced settings](#)

4. Choose whether you want to block pop-ups or not
